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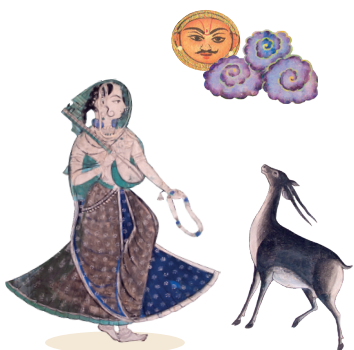

2022 – Vivid straw-yellow green colour. Bright and shiny. Intense nose and elegant aromas with hints of white stone fruits and white flowers.
- Belezos Rioja Blanco Oak Aged Bodegas Zugober, Rioja, Spain** 56
2020 – This Rioja Blanco is rich and elegant, combining fruit and spice offering stylish white blossom aromatics and concentrated fruit flavours spiked with cinnamon. Made by Bodegas Zugober, a family winery in the heart of the Rioja Alavesa region.

2020 – Dry Riesling from Germany's Mosel Valley, fragrant with orange peel and bergamot, herbaceous in the mouth with rhubarb, gooseberry and a fine streak of minerality.

2021 – Delicate aromas of green apple and conference pear, with refreshing citrus and white peach flavours on the palate. Purity and minerality is underscored by a fresh pepperiness.
- Bernkasteler Badstube Riesling Kabinett Feinherb Dr H Thanisch, Mosel, Austria** 85
2018 – Rich with a pronounced bite of acidic tension and a salty tang on the finish, which works brilliantly with the slaty minerality – beautifully balanced. The precise finish is rounded out by a lovely fleshy fruit residue coating the mouth.
- Rudesheim Berg Schlossberg Riesling Trocken Erstes Gewachs, Schloss Schonborn, Rheingau, Germany** 115
2015 – tarts wonderfully dry, grippy and aromatic. Balanced and complex, this dense white wine presents itself on the palate. In the finish, this white from the wine-growing region of Rheingau finally inspires with considerable length.

2022 – complex white wine with a touch of exotic intrigue. Aromas and flavours of honeysuckle, apple crumble, blossoms and honey. Some waxy notes and a long, pithy finish.
